





















The urban and port ensemble of Corfu, dominated by its fortresses of Venetian origin, constitutes an architectural example of outstanding universal value in both its authenticity and its integrity.

The overall form of the fortifications has been retained and displays traces of the Venetian occupation, but primarily interventions from the British period.

Corfu was a well thought of example of fortification engineering and it proved its worth through practical warfare.

As such, it can be placed alongside other major Mediterranean fortified port cities.
