I would like to show you two short presentations of typical revitalization of public areas in Český Krumlov.

First presentation is about the revitalization of south meander of the Vltava river.

This revitalization has been lasting for 14 years.

The other prezentation is about the revitalization of the monastery of Český Krumlov.

This revitalization lasted 14 months.

Renewal of a long-term neglected historical town district – territory of South meander of the Vltava river This part of town has a lot of buildings in art nouveau style

The project involves the renewal of following territories and buildings:

- Municipal park
- Fotoatelier Seidel Museum
- Synagogue
- Egon Schiele Garden Studio and Southern Terraces
- Rose Garden

Implementation time: 2001 - 2015

Total cost: CZK 89 mio (Euro 3 mio)

Participation: CZK 51 mio (Euro 1.9 mio)

Financed from subsidies of state budget, European Union and private sources.

#### 1. Municipal park - revitalization

Municipal park, revitalization co-financed by the EU in the scope of the ROP NUTS II Southwest.

#### 6. Rose Garden

The partial revitalisation of Rose Garden was supported financially by Pivovary (Breweries) Staropramen, a.s. Implementation time: 2005 - 2006

Subsidy of Pivovary Staropramen: CZK 249, 000 Town's investment: CZK 161, 000 Total cost: CZK 410, 000 EUR 15, 000





#### 7. Southern terraces

Southern terraces surrounding Egon Schiele Atelier, partial revitalization co-financed from the state budget through the program of CR's Ministry of Culture.

Beginning of project preparation in 2006 Completion of project preparation in 2010 Subsidy allocation in 2012 - 2015 Beginning of constructional work in 2012 - 2015 Project completion in 2012 - 2015

## 8. Strenghtening of relationships among sights of the Vltava river southern meander in Český Krumlov

Project is split into three parts:

Part I: making accessible and passable the terraces surrounding Egon Schiele Garden Studio

Part II: creation of representative access for visitors (pedestrians) from historical centre into the municipal park

Part III: extension of walkways system in Rose Garden

Part IV: prepared is the design study for space underneath terraces and one of the first steps of this project will be creation of entrances into the Vltava river.

Implementation time: 2007 (start of project preparation) 2015 (completion of constructional project work)
