

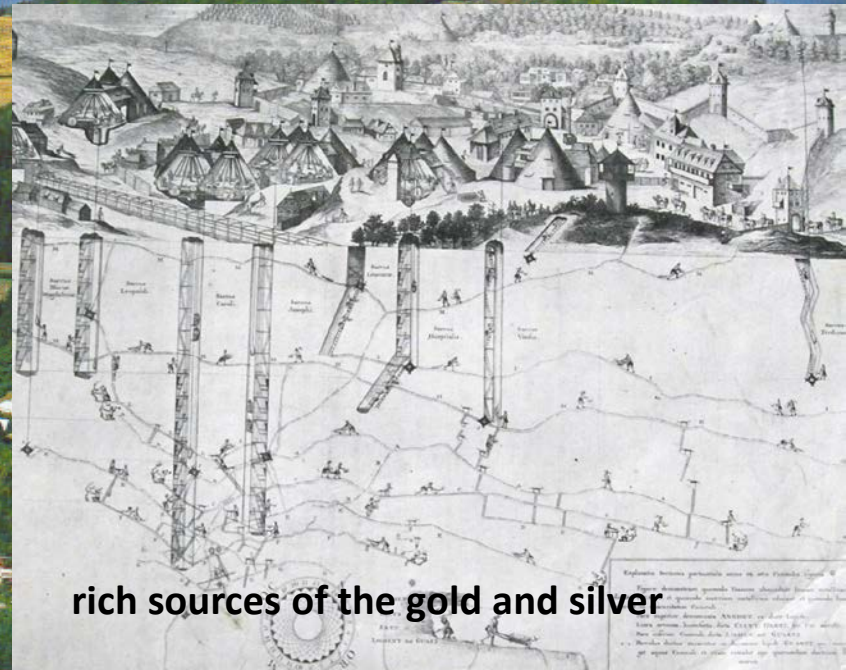

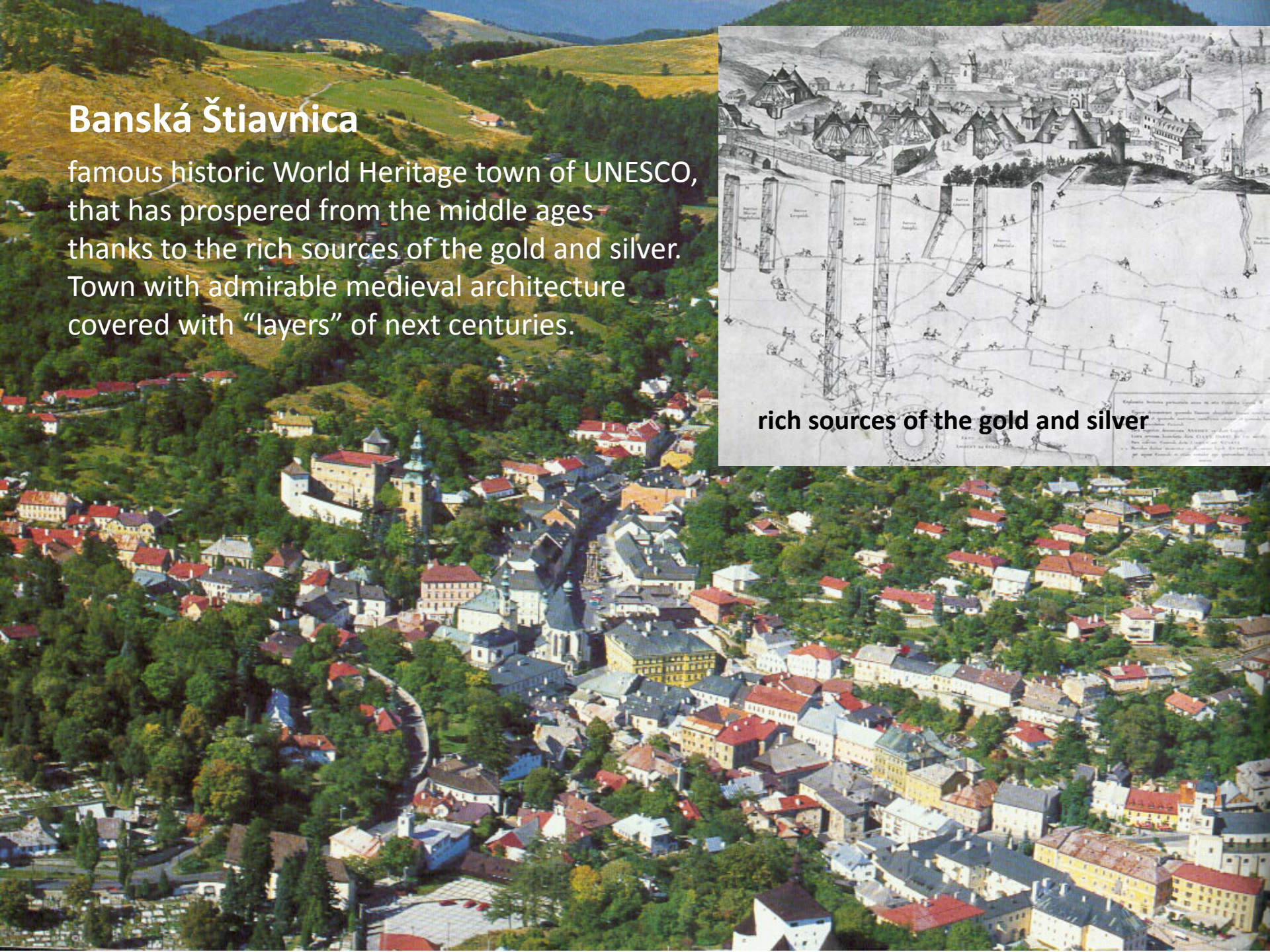

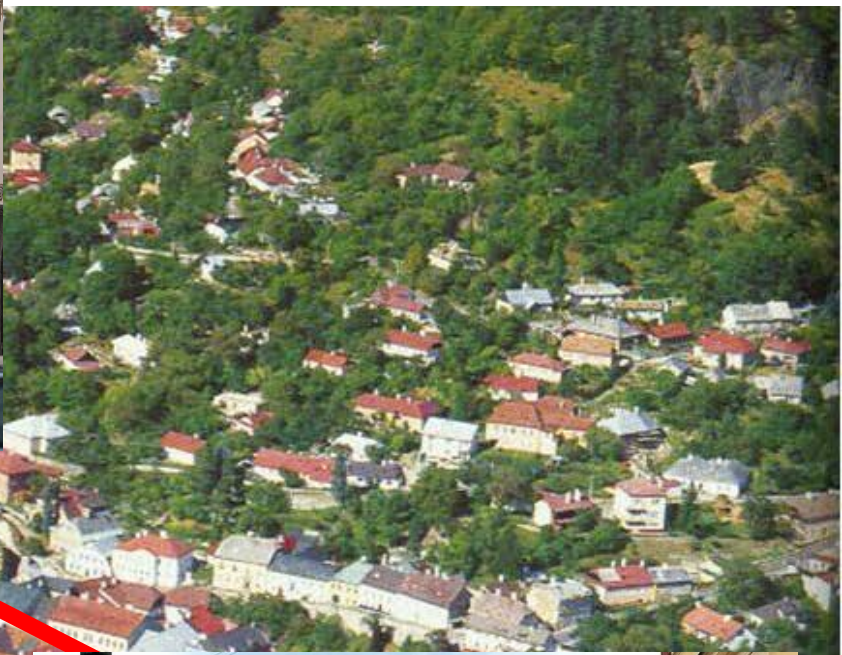
Banská Štiavnica
