## **CALL FOR PAPERS**

The objective of the workshop is to focalize the development of the urban interventions in the historical cities and to put to evidence the potential cultural and economic innovation of their heritage existent in a dynamic civil society, principally integrated with the young people.

The Tunis workshop should discuss and deepen the reflection regarding the theme of the urban innovation, the ideas and the projects (cultural, associative, private sectors) concerned with historical cities.

This theme should emphasize the possible improvement of the young people to re-appropriate the urban historical spaces in the ancient towns.

The development of the "Journées du Patrimoine" and all the other forms of the periodic meetings organized with the civil society and the young people are today a good means for the valorization and the enhancement of the cultural heritage.

The success of these events and exhibitions organized by the civil society in the Mediterranean countries are the evidences of the local urban dynamism between

the public organizations and the private citizens.

The different experiences and realized opportunities in the Mediterranean countries should be discussed in the workshop days in a comparative perspective.

**Communications:** 

The communications presented should be deal with particular attention to social and economic aspects into the historical towns. These could be examples of good practice or case studies at different scales. They will not overlook the policies and strategies put in place to raise the awareness of young people and their involvement in the contract of the built having as

in the upgrading of the built heritage.
