Teresa Colletta is an Architect having graduate from the Naples University Federico II (1971). She holds a diploma of Specialist degree, Post-Graduate Specialization School on Restauro dei Monumenti e Urbanistica dei centri antichi, Naples University Federico II (1974). She is professor of urban history at Architecture Department, University of Naples Federico II and since 2006 is working in the framework of the Interdepartmental Centre in urban Planning Alberto Calza Bini.

Teresa Colletta she has been responsible for a numerous research projects having an important research activity upon the town-planning and historic themes related to a constant urban conservation outlook. Since 1987 is scientific responsible of the review Storia dell'Urbanistica /Campani, and she has produced numerous publications and books.

Teresa Colletta became a Member of ICOMOS Italy National Committee in 1980, member of the ICOMOS Italian Board Committee in 2005 and Secretary General in 2009-13.

She joined CIVVIH as expert member in 1996 and became member of CIVVIH Executive in 2009, V. President in 2012 and president of CIVVIH Mediterranean Sub Committee in 2014. She participated and organized the CIVVIH GA in Naples (2012) as other important meetings of the Committee.

Teresa Colletta is also an expert member of ICTC (2002), ICOFORT (2004).

She has been working in the ICOMOS group for scientific collaboration for the historical WHL center of Naples management plan of the (2010-2011). and she conducted many important missions and desk reviews for the WH work of ICOMOS
