- Capitals in **later periods (475-660)** of Baekje Kingdom  
(18BC-660)
- Serial nomination with 8 components

Gongju	Capital	475-538	<b>Gongsanseong Fortress, Royal Tombs in Songsanri</b>
Buyeo	Capital	538-660	<b>Archeological site in Gwanbukri and Busosanseong Fortress, Jungrimsa temple site, Royal Tombs in Neungsanri, Naseong City Wall</b>
Iksan	Secondary Capital		<b>Archeological site in Wanggungri, Mireuksa temple site</b>

- Inscribed in 2015 with criteria (ii)(iii)

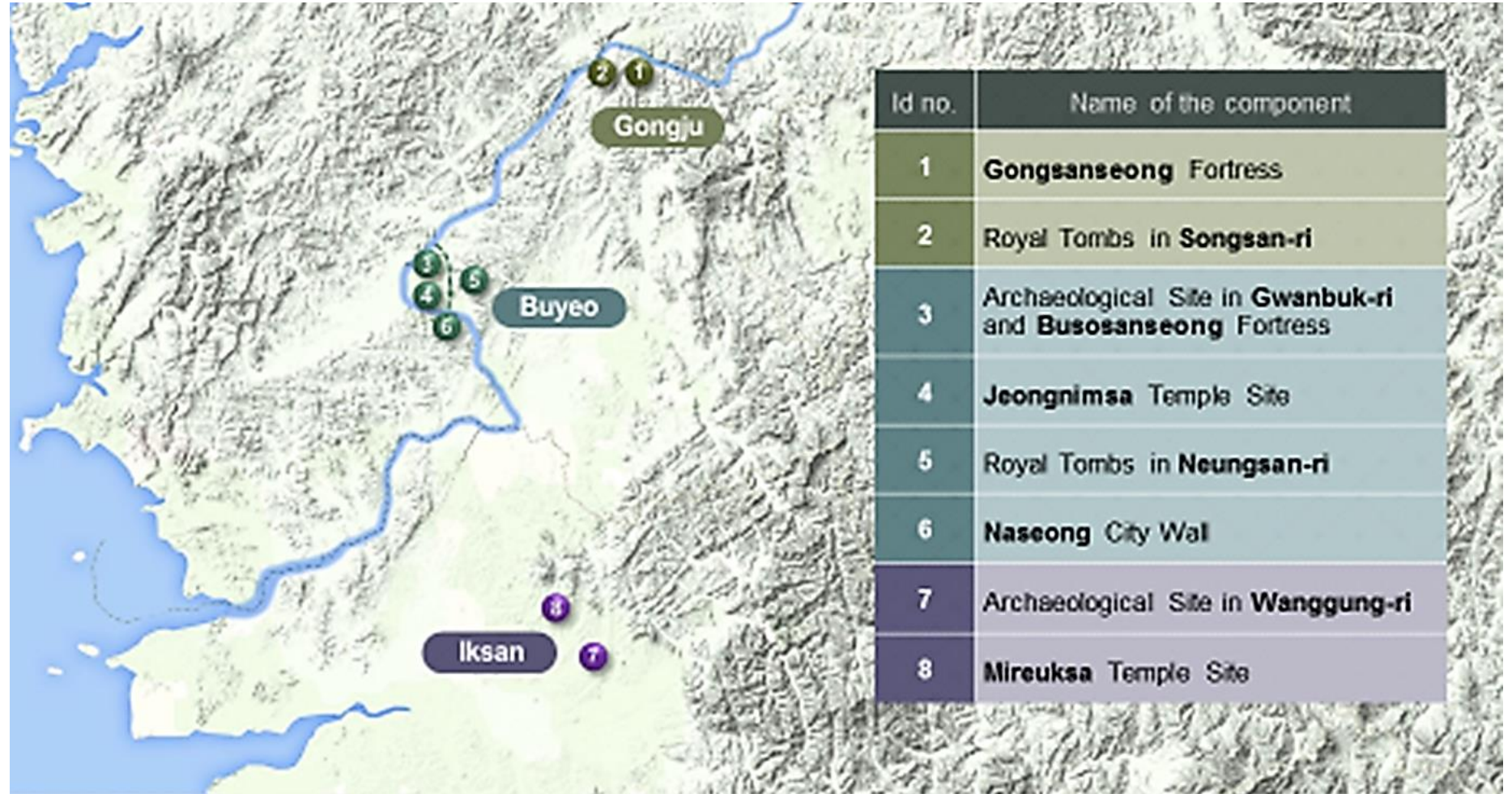
