



### **Nomination Proposal as Honorary Member posthumously: Sémia Akrouit Yaïche**

**Sémia Akrouit Yaïche** has been the Director of the Association for the Safeguarding of the Medina of Tunis (A.S.M), 1993-2013, Vice-President of the Board of Directors of the OWHC from 1994 to 2001 and recipient of the Aga Khan Award for Architecture twice, in 1995 and 2010.

She served as member of ICOMOS Executive Committee 2011-2014 where Sémia worked on several matters concerning the historical cities and urban areas.

She also developed a very close cooperation with CIVVIH, where she participated in many proceedings of the Committee concerning historic towns. A few months before her passed away in April 2015, Sémia had expressed her wish to become a member of CIVVIH.

Having in mind the content of the attached document which better describes Sémia's professional career and contribution to ICOMOS/CIVVIH, very respectfully, we recommend the Committee to award the title of **Honorary Member of CIVVIH posthumously** to our beloved colleague **Sémia Akrouit Yaïche**.
