The Nicosia Master Plan – 25 years of bi-communal work

The Nicosia Master Plan Project Document was signed in early 1980, with several immediate objectives:

- To present a diagnostic survey of the existing situation;
- To prepare an inventory of problems;
- To identify proposals for measures to be taken to address these problems;
- To ensure a wide exchange of views on the proposed measures between all parties with an interest in the Nicosia Master Plan project;
- To prepare a physical Master Plan compatible with the cultural and socioeconomic aspects of Nicosia as a whole.

Twenty-five years later and through the close collaboration of Greek and Turkish Cypriots significant by-communal projects have been implemented and efforts for the regeneration of a re-unified Nicosia continue.
